Registration: Pine Street Inn will inform you of the details of the Boston Athletic Association registration process after your application is accepted by Pine Street. All applicants will be notified of Pine Street's decision in as timely of a manner as possible. The B.A.A. charges a \$125 race entry fee that does not count toward your fundraising minimum. This fee will be collected at a later date. You should NOT contact the B.A.A. directly to secure your number.

Release Form and Contribution Agreement:

In consideration of my accepting this entry, I hereby for myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, waive and release any and all rights and claims for damages I may have against Pine Street Inn and sponsors for any and all injuries suffered by me in said event. I further attest and certify that I am physically fit and have sufficiently trained for competition in this event, and a licensed medical doctor has verified my physical condition. I also grant permission for use of my name and/or photograph or voice in broadcast, telecast, print or any other account of this event.

I agree to collect a minimum of \$2,500 for Pine Street Inn by April 1, 2006. If I have not reached the minimum in sponsorship by that date, I will be personally responsible for the balance owed. Likewise, I agree to have collected a minimum of \$500 by December 31, 2005, and a minimum of \$1,000 by January 27, 2006. If I have not reached either of these minimum amounts by the appointed dates, I will be personally responsible for the balance owed.
